

Warren Petersen Scholarship:

Warren Petersen (1923-2001) was a teacher and administrator at Morrisonville Jr/Sr High School from 1953-1985. He earned his Bachelor's Degree from Carthage College, where he met Betty Phelps. Betty and Warren were married on June 10, 1950. They came to Morrisonville in 1953 and spent most of their lives living and teaching in Morrisonville, IL.

Warren Petersen was a WWII Veteran, serving in the 2nd U.S. Calvary as a member of General George Patton's Third Army. He was an active leader of the Morrisonville and State Kiwanis and his wife Betty sponsored the local Kiwanis Key Club. He was also a member of the American Legion. Warren was a beloved husband, teacher, uncle and friend.

- This scholarship is for \$1,000.00 for a deserving Morrisonville High School senior.
- The scholarship award is for one year only and is given out annually.
- This award is intended to assist students with the cost of tuition and fees needed for college.
- Applicants must complete the attached scholarship application.
- In addition to completing the attached scholarship application, a short essay based on the following will need to be included: Because the Kiwanis Key Club organization focused on building self-esteem and developing leadership skills in high school youth and was centered on making a commitment to community service, the applicant should share how he/she could further develop these attributes and use these skills to improve the Morrisonville Community.
- Also the applicant will need to provide two (2) letters of recommendation.
