PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- ExceleRate Illinois Gold Circle of Quality designation for this school year (in packet)
- Aug & Sept activity account balances (in packet)
- More remote learners have returned. Now have less than 20 remote learners. 10 more hotspots purchased. They help tremendously for students and staff.
- 1st quarter remote learner feedback. Teachers collected from in person learners (who were 2 week remote), and I sent out a survey to our remote learners. I shared feedback to individual teachers. Nearly all was positive.
- RRW and Halloween went well. Student participation was high and everyone was well behaved. For RRW, students participated in daily trivia contest and a coloring contest, sponsored by SADD and JHSC. Thank you to those organizations and their sponsors for their hard work.
- Take & Make Makerspace and STEM kits were organized by Mrs. Goebel and Mrs. Brown. On Fridays, students wanting to participate take home a kit, complete the activity, take a picture of their completed project, and return the kit for another. Students receive a treat after every 4

projects completed. A thank you to Casey's and Sixth Street Market for providing these incentives.

- Surveyed teachers about a wish list for their classrooms. The overwhelming response was books, so each teacher has \$100 to spend on books for their classroom libraries.
- MAP scores

Our JH has a Makerspace class, kids are doing well and enjoying it. Making things and have file for the 3D printer. Limited on what we can do due to IDPH health guidelines but the kids are being creative. Kids are doing great despite all the circumstances this school year. Staff does a great job with the mask and distancing. Plan to return the Monday November 30th. MAP scores, we showed gains in all areas. HS above the mean or right at the mean.
