## REOPENING PLAN

This one-page document serves as a summary of Morrisonville CUSD 1's plan to reopen schools for the 2020-2021 school year based on information currently available during Illinois Phase 4. **The First day of attendance is Wednesday, August 19, 2020.**

Families will have the opportunity to select between full-time in-person learning or full-time online learning to begin the 2020-2021 school year. **Online registration begins August 3rd and will end August 7th.**

### Full In-Person Learning:

- \*All instruction led by MCUSD teachers.
- \*Maximize instructional focus on critical skills, specifically in math, reading, and writing skills.
- \*Ensure a focus on social emotional learning and health (physical and mental) and safety.
- \*Staff and students will be required to wear masks indoors except for at lunch.
- \*When weather allows, outdoor eating, learning activities and recess will be strongly encouraged to provide mask breaks.
- \*Transition between in-person learning and periods of online learning may become necessary during the year.

### Full Online Learning:

- \*All instruction led by MCUSD teachers.
- \*Use of online curriculum which is integrated with the district's learning objectives.
- \* Students will be expected to interact with online learning materials consistently and for as much time as in-person school attendees.
- \*Assessment and activities will be mandatory and graded.
- Special Education students eligible for small group/individual in-person or virtual services.
- Must register and opt-in prior to August 7<sup>th</sup>.
- After 9 weeks, students will have the opportunity to switch to in-person or continue for the entire first semester.

### Temperature & Symptom Check

Students' temperatures will be taken daily prior to entering the school building using digital scanners.

Students will not be permitted inside if their temperature is 100.4 or over. Children experiencing any of the following symptoms must stay home: cough or sore throat, fatigue, body aches, new loss of taste or smell, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea.

### Face Coverings

In accordance with direction from the Illinois Department of Public Health and Illinois State Board of Education, all students, staff, and visitors will be required to wear a face covering while at school and on the bus. Face coverings will not be required while outdoors and socially distanced. A physician's order noting a specific medical reason will be required for anyone seeking to be exempt.

### Sanitation and Cleaning

Electrostatic misting of disinfectant will be done consistently during off hours and when students are not in classrooms. Our custodial staff will engage in wiping surfaces to disinfect throughout the day. Student and staff safety is our highest priority.

### Arrival and Dismissal

Upon arrival at school, students have their temperature scanned, sanitize hands, and go directly to their classroom. A grab-and-go breakfast will be available for students. Students may enter as early as 8:00 and will be dismissed by 2:00. All busses will have assigned seats and students must wear masks. Decisions about after school activities and team sports will be made on a season-by-season basis following guidance from ISBE, IDPH, IESA, and IHSA.

### The School Day

- High School/Jr. High Schedule: 8:15-2:00 MGS Schedule: 8:15-1:50 (Students may enter buildings at 8:00)
- Students are encouraged to bring a clear water bottle to school each day and will be allowed to refill it as needed.
- Desks will be disinfected in between classes.
- Students will social distance six feet apart while eating and only eat and have recess with their own grade level.
